Purpose of processing:

Ensuring fulfilment of legal and other duties and requirements for performance of work by the Company, as well as internal support and ensuring running and activities of the Company.

Legal basis for processing:

Fulfilment of legal duties of the Company and support based on the legitimate interest of our Company in the efficient fulfilment of internal obligations, requirements, and tasks related to providing conditions for work, internal support, running, and activities for efficient management, organization of the Company in compliance with Art. 6 (1) (c) and (f) of Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation), in its wording in force.

Legitimate Interests of the Controller:

Effective fulfilment of legal and internal duties, requirements, and tasks related to reducing the risk of introduction and transmission, as well as the implementation of measures to suppress the spread of COVID-19 virus and related risks, which cannot yet be precisely defined in relation to nature and the full range of possible individual steps or their consequences,

preparation and introduction of specific individual recommendations, or measures including preventing a person to enter the Company's premises in case of reasons for mandatory quarantine, or detection of increased body temperature as one of the possible COVID-19 symptoms, for increased precaution,

providing for early and immediate response of the Controller, including providing for adoption of early and preventive internal company measures in order to prevent the spread of the virus causing the COVID-19 disease and regarding the risks and possible consequences associated with it.

Recipients or recipient categories:

The aforementioned personal data processing is primarily done within the Company. However, in exceptional cases, the Company may be asked to provide it to some third parties, e.g. employees of the Public Health Authority of the Slovak Republic or some other public authorities for the purpose of their actions and measures related to the spread of virus causing the COVID-19 disease in Slovakia.

Processing period:

For the entire period, but only for the inevitable period, when our Company needs to implement measures to suppress the spread of the virus causing COVID 19 disease. Data on the body temperature measured at the entrance to the Company is processed and assessed immediately and then it is no longer stored.

The Controller does not perform any transfer of personal data to any third country, nor any international organization.

Automated decision making or profiling is not being performed by the Controller.

Rights of the data subject:

The data subject is entitled to have access to the personal data related to them, has the right to its rectification, erasure, limitation of its processing, its transferability, as well as the right to object the data processing.
